GROUP POLICY GUIDELINES ON CORPORATE GOVERNANCE

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

- 1. We believe in the importance of environmental protection and that the pursuit of good environmental practice is in the long-term interests of the business and its stakeholders.
- 2. We are committed to monitoring and managing the environmental impacts of our activities to support the sustainability of the environment.
- **3.** We will comply with all applicable environmental legislation requirements and strive to apply internationally recognised standards where appropriate.
- **4.** We provide training, direction and equipment for employees in environmental matters.
- **5.** We require suppliers to maintain high environmental standards as set out in the Group's Suppliers' Charter which all our suppliers must agree to.
- 6. We manage environmental risks at each operation on a site by site basis, identifying opportunities to conserve and recirculate water, to minimise energy use, to reduce waste, to contain fugitive dust, to cut unit CO₂ emissions from indirect sources of energy and to protect local biodiversity.
- **7.** We will systematically review our performance and will publish reports at least annually on the Group's environmental performance.
- **8.** This policy applies to every business unit and employee of the Group.
